

Glowitz and Roberts to lead Laxers

The women's lacrosse team will be looking to improve upon its 1983 season with the return of a core of experienced players plus a talented and energetic group of freshmen, according to Head Coach Barbara Waltman.

The women are led by the duo of senior four year starters Gale Glowitz and Kelly Roberts.

Glowitz, a center, was a Pennsylvania State All-Conference selection last season when she scored 18 goals in seven games. She also has valuable playoff experience as she was a member of the 1982 team that captured the A.I.A.W. Division III national title, gaining All-Championship Tournament honors.

Roberts, who also was a standout member of the MU field hockey team last fall, returns as the team's top defenseman. In 1983 she received the Outstanding Defensive Player Award by her teammates.

A talented group of experienced juniors also return to help the Marauder's wing positions.

Paula Geno, a third year starter will play the attack wing position as will second year starter Jill Clayton. Another second year starter, Alana Wolownick, will hold down the defense wing position.

A trio of sophomores with considerable varsity experience will also be keys to the Marauders' success this spring.

Cover point Deb Kuzemchak returns for her second full season as

a starter while Brenda Bannan and Jean Pierce will look to move into starting roles based on their considerable playing time last season.

Waltman will be assisted this season by Joanne Garber and Deb Geno. Senior Becky Grady, a standout performer last season, will be participating in an exchange program in Germany during the second half of the semester but will help the squad with conditioning early in the year.

The squad will open their pre-season March 24 when they travel to Delaware to compete in the Sanford Tournament.

They will open the PSAC season with a game at West Chester March 27.
